GREENHOUSE GAS POLICY STATEMENT

Talison is committed to action on climate change and responsible production of lithium mineral concentrates to support the global energy transition. Talison's journey through emissions reduction requires continuous improvement and investments in technology, infrastructure, and people. We aspire to reducing our emissions intensity through innovation, exploring opportunities and responsible management. We recognise our role in supply chains and are committed to reducing the carbon footprint of end products within our sphere of influence.

Our goal is to expand our production without increasing our carbon intensity to 2030, and achieve net zero Scope 1 & 2 emissions by 2050 or earlier. Talison is committed to:

- emissions identification, measurement and reporting of Scope 1 and 2 Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions and energy use in accordance with the National Greenhouse and Energy Reporting (NGER) Act. Our emissions will be calculated annually and be made publicly available. We will review our emissions boundaries annually to ensure we capture all material emissions as we expand operations;
- identifying opportunities for improving energy efficiency and reducing greenhouse gas emissions across our operations. We will implement projects on energy reduction, process design, energy carrier substitution and renewable energy procurement. We will investigate mitigation and abatement opportunities;
- developing an action plan and setting targets for Scope 1 & 2 emissions to achieve our goal;
- factoring climate change and emissions reduction in business decisions and strategy; and
- reviewing and updating our GHG policy every two years, considering any significant changes to our mining and operational activities, new technologies and opportunities for emission reductions.

Addressing climate change requires cooperation and collaboration with all our diverse stakeholders. We seek to develop and maintain strong community and stakeholder relationships with those close to our operations to effect positive change as we progress on our journey.

We will engage with industry, government, and community to increase transparency and sustainability in the supply chain. This policy is underpinned by a GHG Action Plan that details the actions that will be taken to achieve the commitments set out in the policy.

Responsibility for the application of this policy rests with all employees, directors, contractors, suppliers and all who represent Talison.
